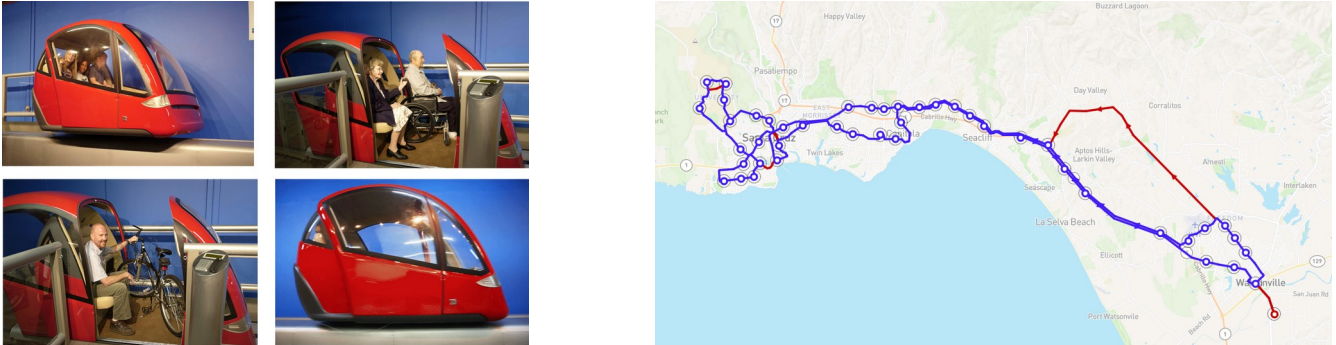


Let's Talk Transportation!
